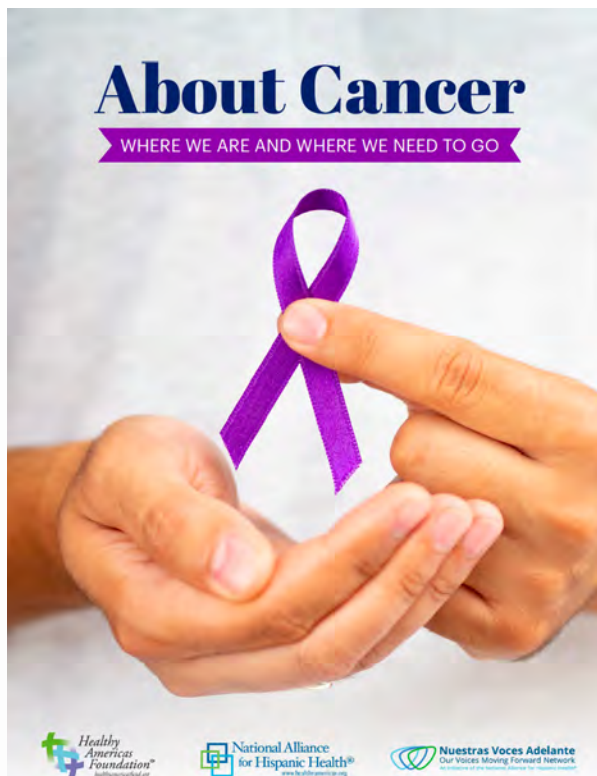

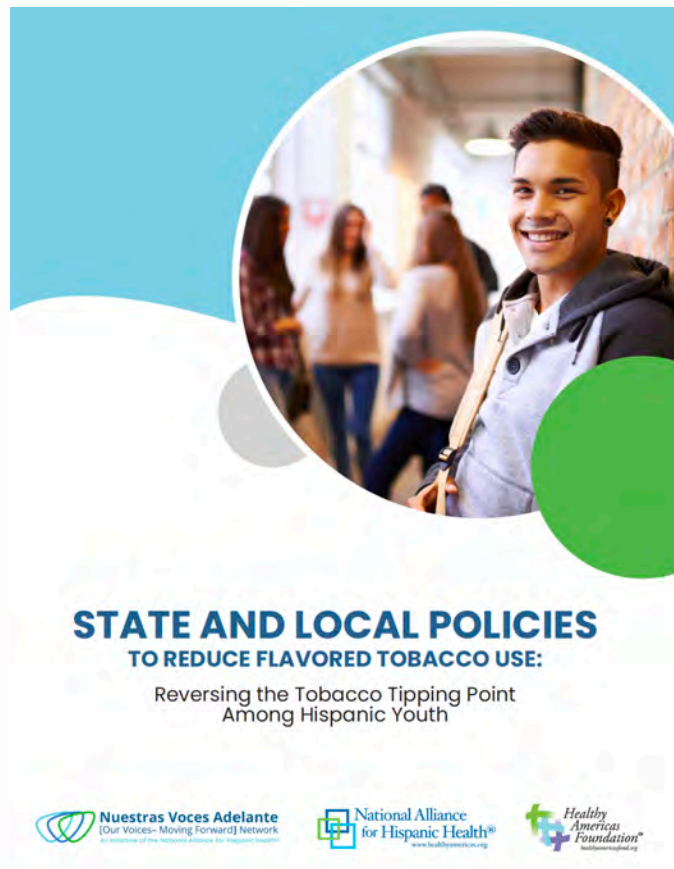

The National Alliance for Hispanic Health recently released the groundbreaking report [State and Local Policies to Reduce Flavored Tobacco Use: Reversing the Tobacco Tipping Point Among Hispanic Youth](#), a comprehensive analysis that reveals the alarming increase in nicotine addiction among Hispanic youth due to the consumption of menthol cigarettes and other flavored tobacco and nicotine products, including e-cigarettes. This policy brief was a joint effort between the Alliance's initiative *Nuestras Voces* (Our Voices) Network and its Healthy Americas Foundation.

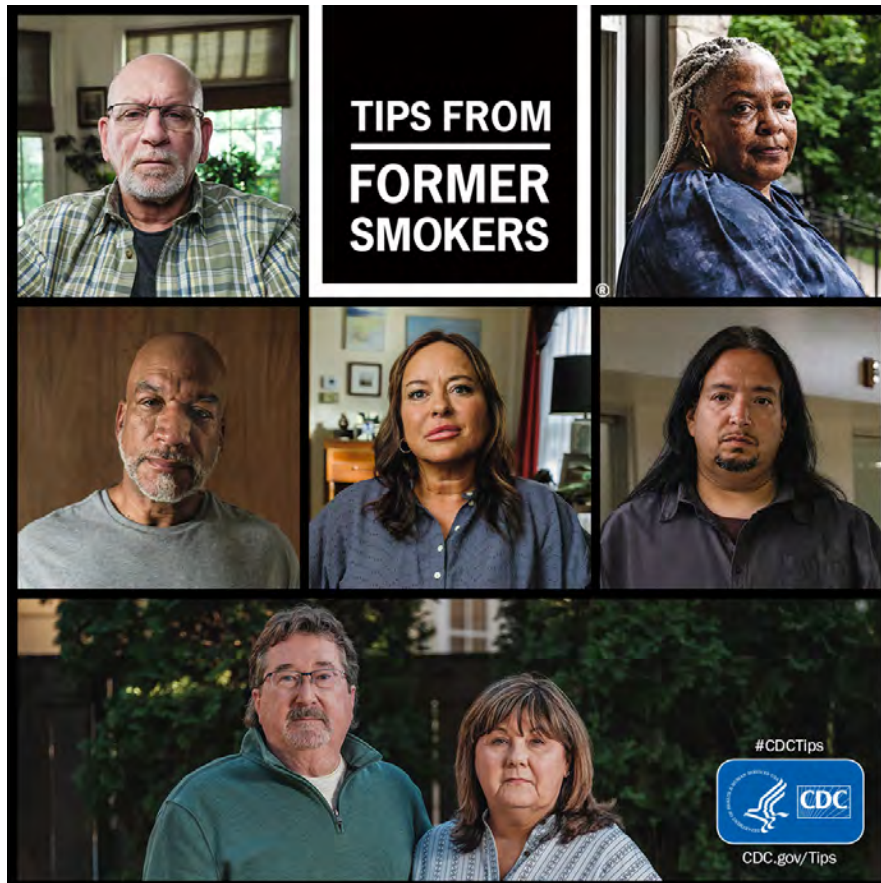

CDC/OSH: Updated Menthol Fact Sheets

State Fact Sheets!

CDC's Office on Smoking and Health (OSH) has updated the Menthol Fact Sheets that were released for all 50 states and the District of Columbia. These fact sheets were developed to support commercial tobacco control partners with their educational efforts and program activities, given the significant risk menthol cigarettes pose to public health. The fact sheets include state-specific estimates of the number of adults who currently smoke, usually use menthol cigarettes, and are seriously considering quitting smoking; the economic cost of cigarette smoking in the state; the estimated number of adults in the state who would quit smoking if menthol cigarettes were no longer available; state Medicaid coverage for cessation treatments; state smoking quitline utilization; and, the amount of funds CDC provides the state for the quitline.
